Uematsu always tried to challenging the established notions of how to handle the material of clay, its production process, the way it is presented, or what ceramic art ought to be. This attitude gave rise to his unique way of expression that envelops the unwavering appearance of clay in stillness and emotion, Eiji Uematsu



A new large-scale installation that scatters countless ceramic pieces across a 5m high gallery wall likened to a sky, and tries to directly project the overlapping of the self and nature, life and expression, onto the space.
